

Children's University Online: Award structure

Children gain stamps for activities they take part in beyond the classroom, they can collect these in their Passport to Learning and enter them into Children's University Online. This unlocks additional information about the activity they have attended such as skills and categories of learning they have engaged with and how many hours of learning beyond the classroom they have achieved. The aim is to gain enough hours over a period of time to allow them to graduate and gain a certificate for their efforts. You can find the Children's University award structure below. This will tell you how many hours is required to graduate and hit each award level/certificate.
